LOWER SALMON RIVER PRE-TRIP INFORMATION

(Revised 2001)

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Lower Salmon River Gorge allows its visitors to escape the influences of the outside world. It's geological structures, flora and fauna, wildlife, and evidence of early man provide for an interesting subplot to its beautiful water. The river meanders through more than fifty miles of canyonlands before joining the mighty Snake River. We travel through four distinct canyons; Green, Cougar, Snowhole, and Blue. Running through splashy Class III rapids (with several Class IV+), our boats carry everything you need for a deluxe adventure. Meet the challenge of rapids during the day, and relax on giant sandy beaches at night. Choose to pilot your own inflatable or sit-on-top kayak (we provide) or sit in the bow of a guided raft. Our goal is to provide you with the custom river trip of your choosing.

AIR SERVICE TO LEWISTON, IDAHO

The Lewiston airport is served by Horizon Air. Due to the small population base of the area, commercial airline services and routes may change. You can call the Lewiston/Nez Perce County Airport at (208) 746-7962 to check current services. It may also be possible to fly into a larger airport in Spokane, Washington.

LODGING IN LEWISTON

All of our guests stay at the Red Lion Hotel in Lewiston, Idaho. They have shuttle service to and from the airport. Hotel features include a restaurant, lounge, spa, and microbrewery. We have an agreement with the Red Lion to extend a rate of \$74 double or single to our Lower Salmon clients. We recommend staying both the night before and the night after the trip.

MEETING POINT AND TIME

All of our trips begin and end at the Red Lion in Lewiston, Idaho. From Spokane, Washington, take Interstate 195 south through Pullman to Lewiston (one hour and a half). From Boise, take Interstate 95 north through Grangeville to Lewiston (four and a half hours). The hotel is located at 621 21st street.

The evening prior to departure, we will have an orientation meeting a 6:00 PM at the hotel. At this time you will be given your waterproof bags, ammo cans, and any other gear and information you need. We will leave the hotel the morning of the launch between 7:00 and 8:00 AM. We can stop along the way for beverages, fishing licenses, or any other items you need.

You will be back to the Red Lion parking lot by about 5:00 PM on the last day of the trip.

Join us for an overnight trip through Green Canyon. For groups of 12 or more only. Call for pricing and availability.
